Documentation Updated: All documentation was reviewed, but none was in need of updating.

Assurance Continuity Maintenance Report:

The vendor for the webMethods Fabric, webMethods Inc., submitted an Impact Analysis Report (IAR) to CCEVS for approval on 4 May 2006. The IAR is intended to satisfy requirements outlined in Common Criteria document CCIMB-2004-02-009, "Assurance Continuity: CCRA Requirements", version 1.0, February 2004. In accordance with those requirements, the IAR describes the changes made to the certified TOE, the evidence updated as a result of the changes and the security impact of the changes.

Changes to TOE:

The changes that were made were to the installer of the TOE, rather than to the TOE itself. These changes consist of addressing some minor bug fixes. There was also a change made to accommodate the installation of the TOE on a Solaris operating system running on Opteron.

Conclusion:

The changes to the Installer do not affect the functionality or the security of the TOE, no new procedures are required, and no additional guidance or warnings to the user need be supplied. Therefore, the changes would qualify as minor. Certificate maintenance is the correct path to continuity of assurance.

Therefore, CCEVS agrees that the assurance is maintained for this version of the product.
