

Canadian Common Criteria Program Endorsement Statement

Network Device collaborative Protection Profile v2.2e

21 October 2021

- 1. The Certification Body for the Canadian Common Criteria Program formally endorses the *Network Device collaborative Protection Profile (NDcPP)* version 2.2e, dated 23 March 2020.
- The Certification Body recognizes a need for evaluated products that are suitable for the use cases identified in the NDcPP and considers the Security Problem Definition and Security Functional Requirements appropriate for the intended use cases.
- 3. The Canadian Common Criteria Program certifies products against the requirements of the NDcPP, and products that comply with recognized Protection Profiles are recommended for deployment within government and critical infrastructure sectors.
- 4. The Certification Body will revisit its endorsement during each subsequent release of the NDcPP and its Supporting Document. If the Certification Body continues to endorse subsequent releases of the NDcPP and its Supporting Document, an updated Endorsement Statement will be published.
